

Legally Blind parachute jump this Saturday

It will be a huge leap of faith over Semaphore this Saturday (November 12), when legally blind RSB client Christian Stafford, jumps from a plane... into the unknown.

Christian and his good mate Kriss, recently undertook a "Challenge for Charlie", raising over \$3,000 for the RSB, to qualify for the jump.

When Christian, a Paralympian who swam at the Sydney games, navigates his way around while on the ground, he can rely on his RSB Guide Dog, Isla. He will have no such assistance while dropping from 15,000 feet.

"I'm really looking forward to the experience, but ask me again just before I jump out of the plane", says Christian.

Christian's jumping group meets at the **Semaphore Surf Life Saving Club for a 9:00am briefing**, before being bussed to Parafield Airport. **The jump takes place at 10:30am** with Christian touching down on the beach in front of the Life Saving Club.

All skydives are subject to prevailing weather conditions. For confirmation, call Coastal Skydives on 0448 148 490 from 7:00am on the day of the jump.
