Discreetly clipped onto the side of normal spectacles, Orcam glasses are intuitive, fitted with a smart camera and software that converts what is being seen into an audio feed, heard by the wearer. Product demonstrations will be held during the event.

A wide range of exhibitors will have products on display, including portable electronic magnifiers, CCTV magnifiers, refreshable braille devices and the latest apps, software and e-book readers.

There will also be a variety of new product demonstrations and guest speakers, including case studies from people using adaptive technology in their daily lives.
