The types of support the NDIS may fund include:

Independent living services, to assist with cooking, cleaning, and safety

Transport

Workplace assistance

Counselling and support services

Equipment, aids and assistive technology

Home assessments and modifications

Health and wellness activities

Mobility equipment, including a white cane, the use of smart apps for mobility or a guide dog

Print Alternative Service — accessible formats of information (large print, Braille and audio)

What is the NDIS?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is the Federal Government's new way of providing individualised support for people with a permanent disability. With the NDIS, you will have more choice and control over the support and services you receive and have far greater say in how you live your life.

What will the NDIS fund?

Support services funded by the NDIS will help increase your independence, social and economic participation, and your capacity to actively participate in the community. The NDIS will pay for supports that are relevant to your disability and required for your everyday life and to achieve your goals.
